

Rev. Dr. Victoria Kumorowski

Rev. Dr. Victoria “Vickie” Kumorowski earned her Juris Doctorate from Washburn University School of Law, in Topeka, Kansas. After practicing law for fifteen years in Kansas, she became a state trial court judge. While serving on the bench, she used her time off to attend the National Judicial College at the University of Nevada at Reno. While working on a Masters of Judicial Studies Degree, she explored some of the major medical, legal, and ethical issues raised by advances in science and medical technology. Her strong interest in the spiritual issues underlying those issues later led her to change careers, to become an ordained minister, and a Board Certified Chaplain.

Vickie received her Master of Divinity from Phillips Theological Seminary in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and her Doctor in Ministry in Formational Counseling from Ashland Theological Seminary in Ashland, Ohio. During the past ten years, she has served as the director of Spiritual Care at Genesis Health Care System in Zanesville, Ohio. During the past five years, she has also served as an adjunct professor for Muskingum University, teaching online courses in Principles of Biomedical Ethics, Legal Issues in Healthcare, and Global issues and Values. Her strong interest in understanding the inner dynamics of healing from addiction stems from both her personal and professional life experiences, including her work as a chaplain on different psych units.

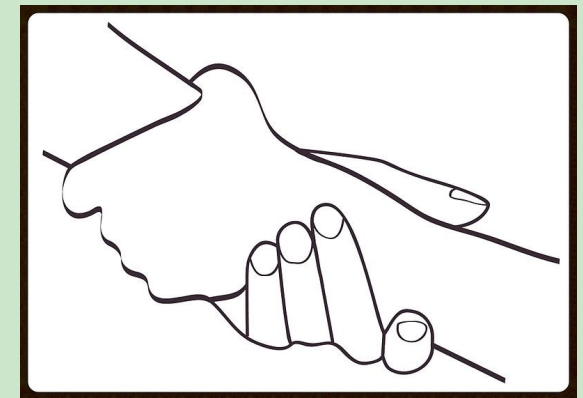

Dr. Labor graduated from the Pennsylvania State University with a Bachelor of Science Degree in BIO Behavioral Health. She attended and graduated medical school in Erie, Pennsylvania at the Lake Erie College of osteopathic medicine.
